This month we celebrate Easter which leads us to ponder some of the events surrounding the resurrection. When we think about the disciples, (remember the ones that fled when Jesus was arrested?) we like to believe that unlike them, we would always be there for our Lord. Nice thoughts, but not always realistic. We are weak and frail, just like the disciples. We get busy and don't have time to pray, not even before meals. Yes, we get distracted in our daily walk with the Lord.

In spite of these shortcomings, Jesus welcomes us. He forgives us over and over again. When we stray, we recognize that we are unable to go it alone in this life. We need help! Can I make some suggestions? Start by making a commitment to spend more time in prayer.

- • Pray over your children-As parents, walk into your child's room and pray for this most wonderful gift that God has entrusted to you. Pray for their safety and well-being for the next week. Pray for their spiritual walk.
- • Begin the habit of going to church. Find a church that believes in the saving grace of Jesus and go! If you don't know where to begin, come and worship with us at Peace. This Sunday is a perfect day to start.
